


Over the past few weeks, I have enjoyed delving into Romans 12 with you, both on paragraphs sunday mornings. We have over of 75 adults Sunday mornings and in mid-week gather-

participating in the "r12: True Spirituality" study, including at least one Sunday School class. And some of those folks have actually taken me up on the challenge to memorize the whole chapter during this six-week series! (I'm not there yet, but I'm still working on it.)

On February 14 (yes, Valentine's Day), we will wrap up the last of the six sessions for our Wednesday evening group. This means, while keeping everything we have learned tucked in our hearts as a treasure, it is time to move on to something new.

For the five Wednesday nights after "r12", leading right up to Holy Week, I have decided to offer the Ray Vander Laan



series called "Walk As Jesus Walked." Some of you are familiar with Vander Laan's studies. My father-in-law Howard introduced us to these last year, and we have presented several on Wednesday nights. Through the video, we are able to take a virtual tour of sites in the Holy Land and other parts of the old Roman Empire. The host blends Biblical teaching with the site-seeing.

So from February 21 to March 21, we will be following a similar format to what we are doing now with "r12." All adults will be invited to meet together in Room 200. We will watch the DVD then spend some time in discussion and application of what we have learned—possibly splitting up into smaller groups for the latter part. As far as I know right now, this will be the only Wednesday night study for adults. I think you will find it very interesting, and I hope you can join us. Some of the topics are a great lead-in to Holy Week.

The details are still being worked out, but I'm excited about what we may be able to offer after Easter. Several studies are in the works, including "Goliath Must Fall: Winning the Battle Against Your Giants," "I Peter: Walk the Talk" and Dave Ramsey's "Financial Peace University." "Financial Peace University (FPU)" is a very popular resource about managing your money (including freedom from debt) from a Christian perspective. It comes highly recommended, and we will be promoting it in the community as well as in the church.

God has blessed us with great resources and gifted leaders. I hope you can take advantage of some of these wonderful discipleship opportunities. God bless you all!




Inclement Weather Policy
