In our July business meeting, the church elected the following nine people to serve with me on the Vision Team to guide our church through a season of seeking God's will for the years ahead:



I have children's music on my brain. This week we are in the middle of VBS. The children are being introduced to new songs, and some are also learning tried-and-true Bible songs. Last week, I was at music camp and witnessed 150 or so children singing together. It's always a blessing to my heart and must surely bring a smile to Jesus' face when children worship him in song.

Did you know that some of our old hymns were first written for children? Here are just a few: “Savior Like A Shepherd Lead Us,” “I Sing The Mighty Power Of God,” “Onward Christian Soldiers,” and “Come Christians Join To Sing” (the word *Christians* originally was *children*).

The Bible tells us to raise our voices in songs of praise to our Lord literally hundreds of times, yet I often feel like we are not encouraging our children to sing. If we don't encourage it at a young age, we will not have youth and adults who want to sing. Who will be our worship leaders for the next generation?

So parents, here's what you can do. If you are in our traditional service, show your child how to follow along in the hymnal. Be a role model. Sing! Even if you don't think you have much of a voice, it will show your children that you believe it's important. If you attend 2nd service, make sure your children are following along with the words on the screen. There are always parts of the songs easily singable by all ages. Once again, sing!

The other thing you can do is have your children participate in Wednesday choirs which will start again in September. This is another opportunity for our children to learn new songs and grow to be active worshippers. We don't know what God has in store, but He may very well be growing up a gifted music and worship leader right here in our midst. Let's not get in His way!
