

- Sunday, April 14 at 12:30 PM


Here is the schedule at the Pole Green Community Building. Sign-up sheets are located in the Commons so we can anticipate numbers:

On Palm Sunday, April 14, the children's choirs will be singing in worship at both of our services at the Pole Green campus. They also will be waving palm branches as they enter the worship center to remind us of Jesus entering Jerusalem for the Passover feast. "From the lips of children and infants You, Lord, have ordained praise." (Matt. 21:16)

The worship choir will present "We Remember Calvary" at our Maundy Thursday service on April 18 at 6:30. This reflective worship experience will include traditional and new songs for choir and congregation, all intended to paint a picture of Christ's last days and His journey to the cross. He was delivered over to death for our sins. (Romans 4:25)

Our Easter Sunday at 8:45 and 11:00, our services at Pole Green will be the same, using the choir and praise team to celebrate Christ's resurrection from the dead.
