JOB DISCRIPTION

This is a paid part-time position expected to average 10 hours per week.

The worship leader reports to the Hebron Site Pastor and the Senior Pastor and has the following responsibilities:

- Work with the ministerial staff to plan and execute meaningful and inspirational worship services, choosing music that engages the congregation and supports the preaching of God's Word.
- Recruit, schedule and train instrumental, vocal, and technical volunteers as necessary for the Hebron campus.
- Plan and oversee rehearsals of a Hebron praise team which not only prepares the team for Sunday worship, but also encourages a sense of unity and a growing relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Model and lead heartfelt worship that draws people in, encourages participation, and points people to Jesus.
- Connect with regular attenders and visitors to the Hebron campus. Participate in outreach activities in the community.
- Have an understanding of the audio/visual components at the Hebron campus.
- Prepare audio-visual presentations for worship.
- Meet with staff on a regular basis for vision setting, worship planning, and coordination of programs and activities.
