The First Coronavirus Edition of Our Church Newsletter

How strange it is to put out a newsletter when most of life as we know it has been suspended. A few weeks ago, our children were in school, the stock market was near a record high, unemployment numbers were at record lows, churches were meeting every week, Spring Break trips were being planned, and there was toilet paper on the store shelves. My, how things have changed!

Unfortunately, much of what I have to share with you is about **what is NOT happening**:

- Until further notice, we will not be having group activities at either of our church campuses. This includes worship services, Sunday School, bible studies, dinners, committee meetings, and all non-church activities in our facilities. Any exceptions will need to be necessary, protected, and rare. Approval will be needed from the church staff in consultation with our healthcare team. Unfortunately, we don't know how long these restrictions will continue. It could be weeks or even months.
- Because of these restrictions, many special events on our April calendar have been cancelled: Palm Sunday services, Maundy Thursday dinner & service, Easter services, the VA Baptist Women's Chorale, Church Council, Youth Spring Retreat, etc.

Even though we will not be gathering for a while as we have in the past, the ministry of the church is certainly not shut down! Let me share with you what IS happening:

- Our church office will continue to operate on limited hours with limited staff. This means there will be someone here to accept deliveries and answer the phone from 8:30—noon, Monday—Thursday. If you need us, please call—but realize our secretaries and volunteer receptionists may not be in the office. Other staff should be able to answer. If you can't reach anyone at the office, you can try the cell phones of staff members. My cell phone number is 804-221-7096, and Pastor Jeff's is 804-314-2946. {If we are able to return to normal office hours before the end of April, we will send out the word!}
- Though we are not gathering in the traditional sense, we are trying to provide some resources to help you worship at home and remain connected to Broadus Church.
 - ⇒ Each weekend, we will post the audio and video of our "worship service" to the church website. You can also access this from the church Facebook page and YouTube. When possible, this will include music from our Praise Team and my sermon, plus maybe some other features! We hope to make Easter as special as we can! [We're working on a possible Easter Sunrise Drive-In Service!]
 - ⇒ I've also posted a Daily Devotional Guide called "The Rough Road to the Resurrection." You can pop into it at any time and reflect on the events leading up to the crucifixion and resurrection.
 - ⇒ We also encourage Sunday School classes and other groups within the church to stay in close contact. Some
 - groups are using Zoom or conference calling in order to talk, pray and study together—but this is left up to each group. Contact your teacher or group facilitator if you have ideas or questions.

 ⇒ One great new initiative is our "InTouch" System. This program will help us get important messages out to the whole church family through recorded phone messages, texts and/or emails. Please take the time to read about it on the back page—and then respond back to the church to be included.
 - ⇒ As time passes, we are exploring more and more options for connecting with all our church family. We will try to keep you well informed.

There are also **things we simply don't yet know**. Many of our activities for May, June and July are simply up in the air. These include the Mo Hope Ministry, Mother"s Day Services, Fun!Friday, Youth Sunday, Hebron Hero Day, Standing Rock Mission Trip, Intergenerational Mission Trip, MFuge Camp, Music & Worship Arts Camp, Vacation Bible School, etc. We will let you know as soon as decisions are made about these things. I like to optimistically believe that most of our summer events can still take place, but I can't make any promises. The health of our church members and community is of utmost importance.

If the church staff can help you in any way, don't hesitate to contact us. Pray for each other every day. Stay healthy and stay faithful! Pastor Phil

You can also submit up to three email addresses. Please try to do this by Sunday, April 5th. We hope to have the system up and running by Easter.

It could be the end of the year before we are able to expand our database of contacts, so respond now and get us off to a quick start. It will be very useful during these days of "social distancing" and in the future. Thanks for participating!
