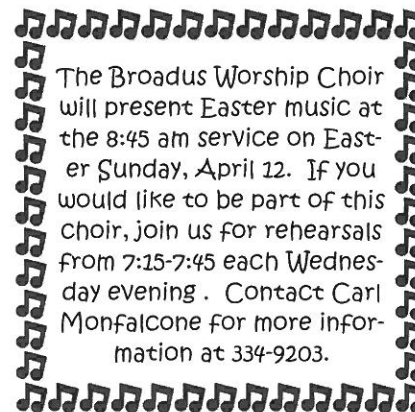
**Moments of Hope**
