





Sermon Notes

The biblical story of Balaam (Numbers 22-24) is about more than just a prophet who gets spoken to by his donkey. It is a cautionary tale of a people, the Israelites, who were often prone to wander from the holiness and righteousness of God to find themselves caught up in the idolatry and immorality of the surrounding tribes. The same thing can easily happen to us today.

How can we avoid internal decay, staying holy in an unholy world?

- Be honest about the unholy influences in your life.

- Allow the Holy Spirit to build your internal, spiritual strength.
- Be accountable.
