### INDOOR PROJECTS (following distancing & masking protocol)

<u>Seasonal Face Masks.</u> Around sociallydistanced tables at church, we will have a group cutting out, sewing and ironing nice face masks for holiday distribution. Help people stay safe, in style! Do you have a sewing machine you can bring? <u>(Pam Bowen, Tia Campbell)</u>

<u>Wreath-Making.</u> Supplies and instructions for crafting simple, cheerful wreaths will be supplied. These will be shared with homebound members and others. (Joan Throckmorton)

Appreciation Baskets. The early part of the morning will be spent assembling goodies and gift baskets which will then be delivered to area fire and rescue squads, sheriff's offices, and some public school teacher lounges. (Laurie Givens)

Cards & Letters of Encouragement. Cards of encouragement are a great way to minister to homebound folks and those in care facilities, especially during this time when visits are discouraged. A great activity and ministry for any age. (Karen Tucker)

#### OUTDOOR PROJECTS

\_\_\_\_\_ **Public School Ministry.** To serve area public schools, we will have teams doing some clean-up, painting and landscaping. (Jeff Poythress)

**\_\_\_\_\_ Firewood.** We will be cutting and splitting wood at the church, but also loading trailers and pickups to make deliveries in Hanover, King William, and King & Queen. Chainsaws, splitters and pickups/trailers are a plus! (Team Leader TBD)

**Nativity Trail Fix-Up & Church Property Projects.** We will have a team cleaning up the trail so it can be used for a simple Christmasweek "Journey through Song." There are also projects around the church grounds that need to be addressed. (Mike Bohannon)

Home Repair and Clean-up. We will have multiple teams going out to do minor house repairs, home winterization, and general cleanup for some families in Hanover and our surrounding counties. Trucks and trailers will be useful if you have one. (Larry Seay, Paul Longest)

**Furniture Painting & Repurposing.** We will be doing creative refinishing and painting of donated furniture, much of which will be designed children's spaces. All will go to help community families. (Kim Rush)
