- ◆ *If you plan to come out of your car and worship in the picnic pavilion, please park in the front parking area or the back gravel lot, leaving the closest “line-of-sight” parking for those staying in their cars. [If you have mobility issues, please park near the pavilion.] Folks in the pavilion or out of their cars must practice social distancing of 6’ from non-family members, and are also strongly encouraged to wear masks.*
- ◆ *To worship from your car, tune your radio to the FM 101. (If reception is poor, try parking closer to the pavilion.) Park so you can see the stage, either from paved lot or the field. We ask that smaller cars park in front and larger vehicles in back.*

- ◆ *Receptacles for offerings and response cards are available as you enter and exit the front driveway, and at the pavilion.*
