# The Light at the End of the Tunnel!

For the past several weeks, all the talk has been about the coronavirus vaccines that have showed great promise in the early trials and have now received FDA approval. Frontline workers and at-risk populations are already beginning to be vaccinated. We have been praying for this all year long. This blessing from God gives us confidence that the pandemic will be brought under control, lives will be saved, and a sense of normalcy can return to our lives!

But seeing a light at the end of the tunnel has its own risks. We need to be careful not to let down our guard too soon! The virus is still raging around us, and it will be some months before true relief arrives.



For that reason, let me remind you of some of the safety guidelines we are following here at church—which are in keeping with the governor's statewide mandates:

- Our worship services and bible study classes are exempt from the 10-person limit for public and private gatherings, but we continue to require masks and social distancing. This is for indoor <u>and</u> outdoor gatherings, at least through the end of January. A good practice is to simply put on your mask whenever you enter either of our campus sites, whether on Sunday or during the week.
- ◆ Disposable and hand-sewn reusable masks are always available at church if you don't have one. We also encourage use of hand sanitizer, which is readily available.
- Worship seating has been arranged to provide for proper spacing. Thank you for diligently allowing six feet (or at least 3 chairs) between your household and others.
- ◆ Those with Covid-19 symptoms or a positive diagnosis or those who have been exposed— should not enter the church until the proper quarantine period has elapsed and they are no longer contagious.
- ♦ Unfortunately, social gatherings (class parties, youth & children activities, family reunions, etc) of more than 10 people are not permitted at this time.
- ◆ As much as possible, committee meetings and other such gatherings should be conducted remotely.
- ◆ Any in-person gathering, including Sunday worship, may be cancelled if there is a local outbreak or undue risk of exposure. Those at highest risk should be extra careful.

Life and health is a sacred gift from God! Let's honor Him and love one another by being careful these next few months.
