
“When Making Money Is Useless” Matthew 6:19-24

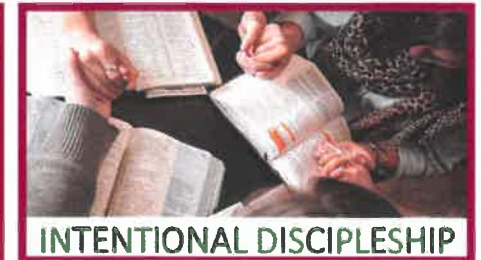
