Please use discretion and respect for others regarding masks and social distancing. Masks are always welcome!



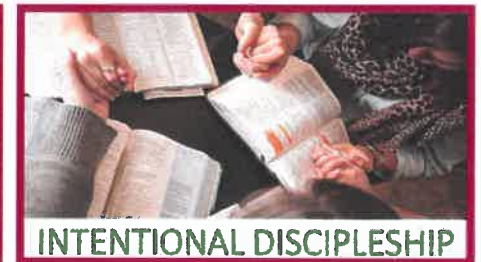
