SERMON NOTES:
Six "G"s of the Gospel
GRATITUDE
Psalm 116:1-19

We are all able to identify with the sentiments of the psalmist who remembered being "*overcome by trouble and sorrow*" in his own life. And yet, in those darkest times, there is a God who hears us, protects us, and saves us.

The question is then asked in verse 12, "*How can I repay the Lord for all His goodness to me?*" In truth, we can never repay the Lord, but we are given some guidance for how to express our gratitude to Him.

- ◆ I will lift up the cup of salvation. (v. 13a)
- ◆ I will call on the name of the Lord. (v. 13b)
- ◆ I will fulfill my vows to the Lord. (v. 14)
- ◆ I will be a servant of the Lord. (v. 16)
- ◆ I will sacrifice a thank offering to the Lord. (v. 17)



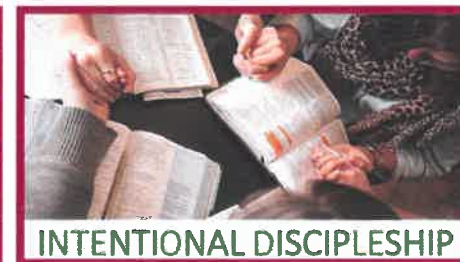

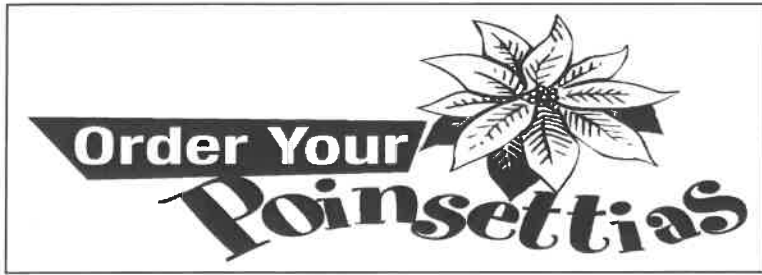
