The Man Born Blind **John 9**

Jesus and his disciples came upon a man who had been blind from birth. Through the physical healing Jesus offered, we are able to learn some valuable lessons about spiritual vision.

- ◆ Spiritual vision sees every challenge as an opportunity. (9:1-5)
- ◆ Spiritual vision helps us understand the importance of obedience. (9:6-7)
- ◆ Spiritual vision doesn’t focus on unimportant issues. (9:13-16)
- ◆ Spiritual vision helps us identify God’s work in our lives. (9:24-25)
- ◆ Spiritual vision shows us the value of pleasing God, not men. (9:28-34)
- ◆ Spiritual vision leads us to place our full faith in Jesus! (9:35-38)



