

"The First Noel" at Hebron



Our Christmas sermon series this month is called "What's In A paragraphs Name?" The messages are based on the names of our Lord found

in the 1st chapter of the New Testament. Matthew 1 just scratches the surface of the titles given to Jesus, but they will help us to understand His place in history and in our hearts.

On Nov. 27th, the first Sunday of Advent, the sermon is titled "What's in a Name: Son of David, Son of Abraham." (My alternate title is "Meet the Parents.") God sent His one and only Son to us through an interesting and unlikely succession of men and women—and they certainly have something to teach us. Then on Dec. 4th, we will look at the title "Messiah." Did you know that "Messiah" and "Christ" mean the same thing, but one is from a Hebrew word and the other from the Greek? It's helpful to understand that "Christ" is not Jesus' last name (like Jesus Smith or Jesus McIntire), but rather an important title. On December 11th, we will look at the name "Immanuel." It is not used often in the Bible, but it is a great reminder that God never leaves us but is with us forever. Then finally, on the Sunday before Christmas, we will focus our attention of the name "Jesus" itself. Did you know it is the Greek form of the Hebrew name, Joshua? It encapsulates the ministry of the One who came to seek and save the lost.

I hope you will join with your Broadus family for worship this month. Merry Christmas!
