SERMON NOTES

**Striving Toward God's High Calling**  
**Philippians 3:12-14**

Today is the beginning of a new year! Rather than getting caught up in stereotypical New Year's resolutions, why don't we study and apply what the Bible teaches about making a new start in life? The Apostle Paul gives us some excellent guidance in his letter to the Philippian believers.

- ◆ We need an attitude of humility.
  - ◇ "Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already been made perfect..." (v.12a)
- ◆ We need the aspiration to grow.
  - ◇ "...but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me." (v.12b)
- ◆ We need to keep a singular focus.
  - ◇ "But one thing I do..." (v.13a)
- ◆ We need to leave the past in the past.
  - ◇ "Forgetting what is behind..." (v.13b)
- ◆ We need to set our sight on the future God has in store!
  - ◇ "I press on toward the goal..." (v.14)

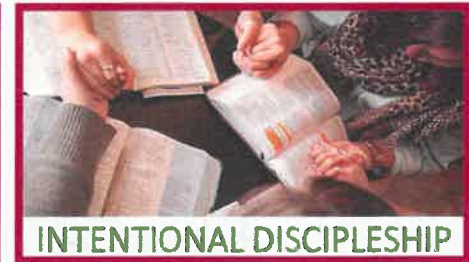
