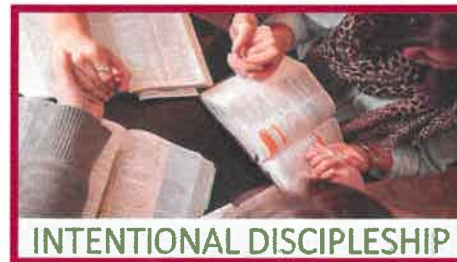

- ◆ More often than calling us to do something different, he calls us to do what we are doing differently.
 - ⇒ Better ethics.
 - ⇒ Better work ethic.
 - ⇒ Better attitude.
 - ⇒ Better relationships.
 - ⇒ Better priorities.
