After he left them, they said to each other, "*Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?*" (Luke 24:32)

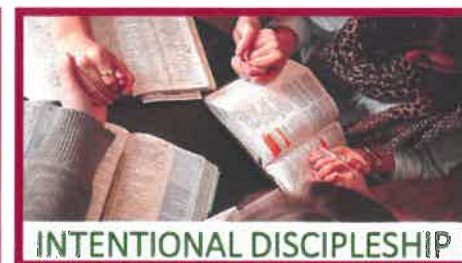
