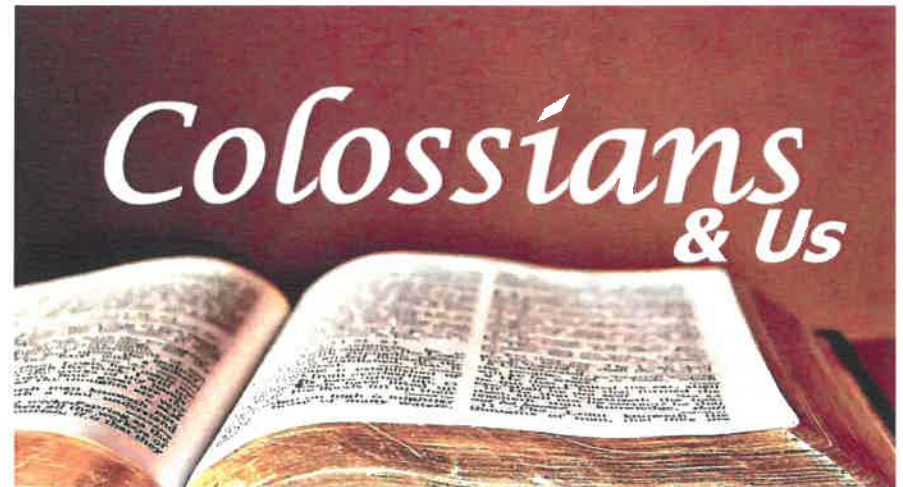

SERMON NOTES
 “The Call to Communicate”
 Colossians 4:2-6

As the Apostle Paul begins to wrap up his letter to the Colossian Christians, he returns to the topic of prayer. He shares how important communication with God is to also being effective communicators of the gospel message.

How to Pray: (v. 2)

- ◆ Faithfully
- ◆ Watchfully
- ◆ Thankfully

What to Pray:

- ◆ Pray for open doors for ministry and witness. (v. 3)
- ◆ Pray to be able to proclaim Christ clearly. (v. 4)
- ◆ Pray for right actions consistent with your words. (v. 5)
- ◆ Pray to be able to witness with wisdom and grace. (v. 6)
