Pastor Call Committee Report

The Pastor Call Committee (PCC) search officially began on Sunday February 16, 2025 and has met once or twice a month since that time. In addition, we've had various workgroups or subcommittees that have met routinely between the full committee meetings, both in person and via Zoom to provide various documents including the Congregation Survey, Church Profile, Pastor Profile and Interview Questions.

Many thanks to each of you who took time to give us your preferences and comments for the survey, and attend the Forum. This has been very useful, and we promise to contemplate all input prior to making any recommendation to call a candidate.

Our next steps will be to publish our information with the Baptist General Association of Virginia so that interested applicants can submit their resumes. The PCC will invite the most appropriate candidates to have interviews, after which we will run background checks, call references, and then finally bring a name forward for the congregation to consider. You will vote to make the final selection. Logistics for this whole process are being developed.

We ask that you please keep praying for the candidates who submit their information to us. God knows who He wants to lead Broadus Church for the coming years, and we pray for His guidance in finding and calling the right person. We also ask that you continue praying for our committee to have God's insight each step of the way.
