

"If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you." - James 1:5

Proverbs 2 records the words of Solomon to his son, and to all who would seek to live their lives guided by godly wisdom.

- The word "IF" points us to the conditions necessary for gaining wisdom.
 - ⇒ Proverbs 2:1-4
- The word "THEN" points us to the results.
 - ⇒ Proverbs 2:5, 9-12
- The words "FOR" helps us understand why we should seek wisdom.
 - ⇒ Proverbs 2:6-8


