#### SERMON NOTES

*The "Fear Not's" of Christmas: "Fear Not, Mary & Joseph!"*  
Luke 1:26-38 & Matthew 1:18-25

After delivering good news to Zechariah the priest, the angel Gabriel was also sent by God to a young woman named Mary, and to her fiancé Joseph. In separate encounters, he told them both not to be afraid. His messages of instruction and encouragement still speak to us today!

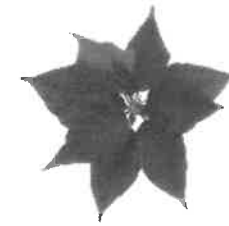
