SERMON NOTES

The "Fear Nots" of Christmas: "Fear Not, Shepherds!"
Luke 2:8-20

In the biblical account of Jesus' birth, it is perhaps the shepherds that best represent everyday people like us. When the angel appeared to them at night in the fields around Bethlehem, he addressed perhaps the greatest fear that many people have—though often unspoken—when he said, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; He is Christ the Lord!"

- ♦ You don't have to live in fear, because God has sent His Savior!
 - ♦ He was sent for ALL people.
 - ♦ More specifically, he was sent for YOU.
