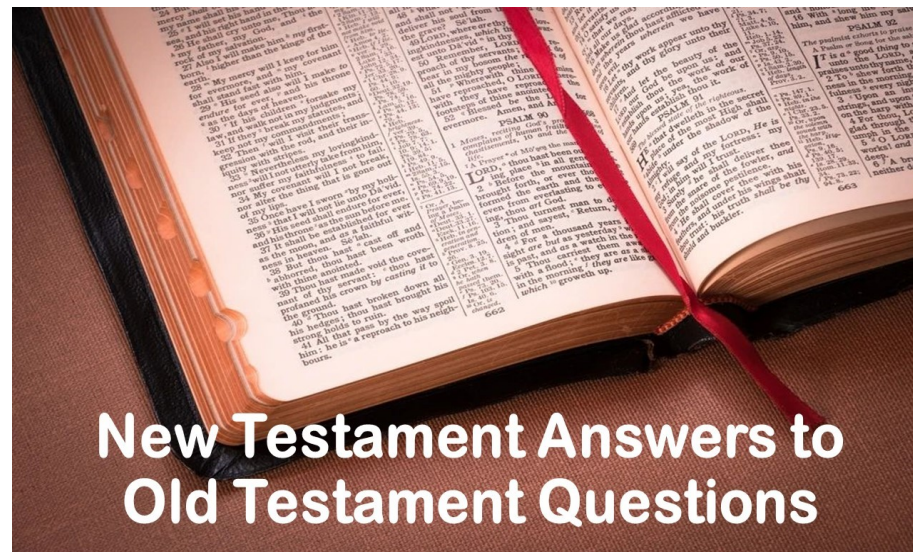

#### SERMON NOTES

Sermon Series: *New Testament Answers to Old Testament Questions*  
*“Is the Lord Among Us Or Not?”*  
 Exodus 17:7

After God delivered the Israelites from their Egyptian bondage, He guided them through the wilderness to Mount Sinai, providing for their needs every step of the way. But once there, as the people became thirsty again, they grumbled and doubted, asking the question so many have asked in times of hardship: *“Is the Lord among us or not?”*

The New Testament reinforces the truth that God never leaves us nor forsakes us (Hebrews 13:5b).

- ◆ God is with us in our times of pain and suffering. (Romans 8:38-39)
- ◆ God sometimes uses hardships to get our attention. (Matthew 11:28)
- ◆ God builds our Christ-like character through our trials. (Romans 5:3-4)
- ◆ God uses our faith response as a witness to the world. (Hebrews 12:1)
